Applicants should have an MSc degree (or equivalent) in atmospheric or climate science, physics, environmental sciences, or a related field. The ideal candidate should have a strong quantitative background and interest in atmospheric data and climate research, programming experience (i.e., Fortran), and experience in handling large data sets. The ability to work independently as well as in a team, excellent writing and communication skills, and the ability to meet deadlines are particularly welcomed.

The position is to be filled as soon as possible and is fixed for a term of 3 years. Salary: TVH 13 (65%).

With a view towards increasing the proportion of females, the Philipps-University Marburg specifically encourages female candidates to apply. Handicapped persons with comparable qualifications receive preferential status.
